

HONORARIA FOR MEMBERS OF PRESBYTERY
GUIDELINES
The Presbytery of Cincinnati

Service rendered to the presbytery is service to Christ and to the church of Christ. Members of the presbytery will normally offer such service without expectation of compensation. In a connectional church, such service is appropriate and expected. We recommend that these expectations be communicated clearly with the presbytery.

Nevertheless, in some circumstances even the most dedicated presbyter may be unable or unwilling to offer time and skills without some level of remuneration. In such cases, we believe that any decision about appropriate honoraria rests in the hands of the planning/sponsoring group. Recent amendments in our denominational constitution support the philosophy that local decisions are best made locally.
