2.0 Participants	125	64
Female	53%	49%
Male	47%	51%

What change has Transformation 2.0 produced among those who participated in a Learning Cohort (LC)?*

- 63%** I have experienced significant personal transformation through 2.0
- 73%** LC is more able to name what God is doing in the midst of their work
- 88%** LC is more willing to experiment with new ways of partnering with God in ministry

How are 2.0 participants thinking and feeling about the future?*

- 83%** We are more hopeful about our future.
- 90%** We feel a desire and are motivated to make changes in order to move into the future.
- 90%** We are asking new questions about what ministry can look like.

Presbytery leaders take risks and give permission for congregations to take risks.




There is excitement about the future of the Presbytery.


How hopeful are you about the future life and ministry of the Presbytery of Cincinnati?
