Located at the corner of Clifton and Bryant Avenues in the heart of Clifton (Cincinnati, OH) and near the University of Cincinnati, Immanuel is a great place to apply your musical gifts with its friendly, supportive congregation and staff. Our church is deep in resources: an adult choir, praise band, hand bells, children's music, pipe organ, piano, keyboard, and an extensive music library.

Our ideal candidate would be comfortable performing the following tasks:

- Provide leadership in developing a relevant musical program;
- Select and direct pieces representing a wide range of musical styles;
- Work with the pastor to develop music for the weekly Sunday service;
- Rehearse the 12-member (SATB) adult choir once a week;
- Warm up and direct choir at the church as required on Sunday mornings (Service currently at 10:30 a.m.);
- Supervise organist and section leaders;
- Direct the church praise band for a monthly worship service;
- Arrange for and supervise special music (soloists/instrumentalists) during summer months when the Chancel Choir is on break;
- Prepare special musical programs - including extra rehearsals - at Christmas and Easter;
- Supervise and/or prepare the children and youth for occasional performance during worship;
- May serve as keyboardist, as required.

This is a twelve-month position, with work week estimated to be 15 - 20 hours. Salary is competitive and is commensurate with skills and experience. Keyboard skills are a plus.
